**Directions:** Design your own paper airplane. Write down the steps required to make your plane. If there is time, test your plane design against someone else's to see whose flies the furthest.

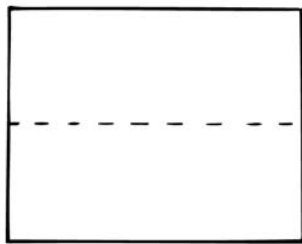

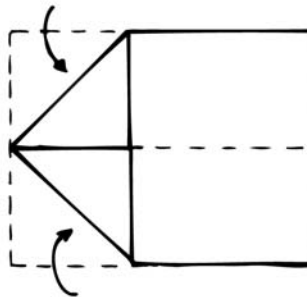

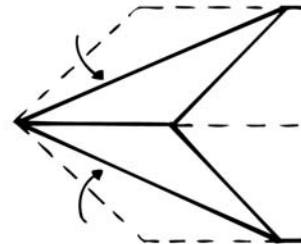
# Example of Paper Plane Instructions



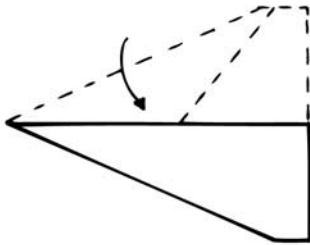
① Fold paper in half to make a crease.



② Fold each corner into the middle.



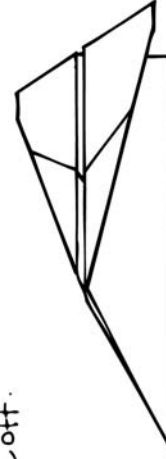
③ Fold each top edge in towards the middle - line up with the center crease.



④ Now fold paper in half



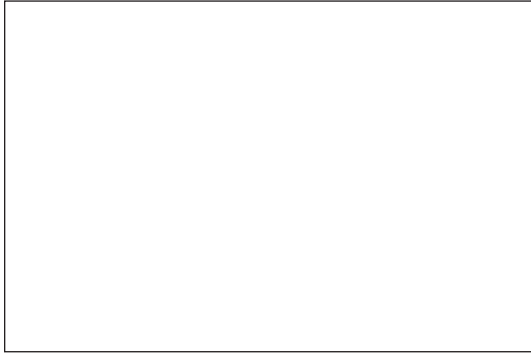
⑤ Fold the side(s) down about half way - these are the wings.



⑥ Level the wings out straight... ready for take-off.

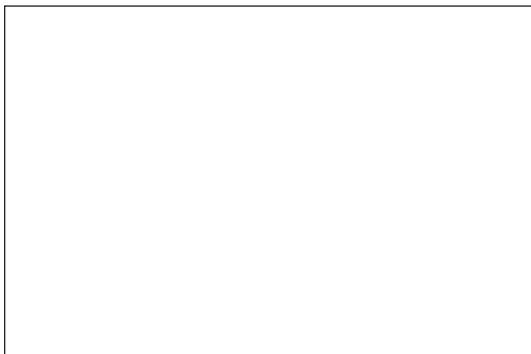
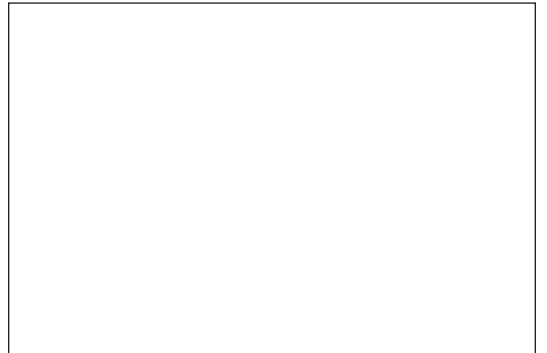
