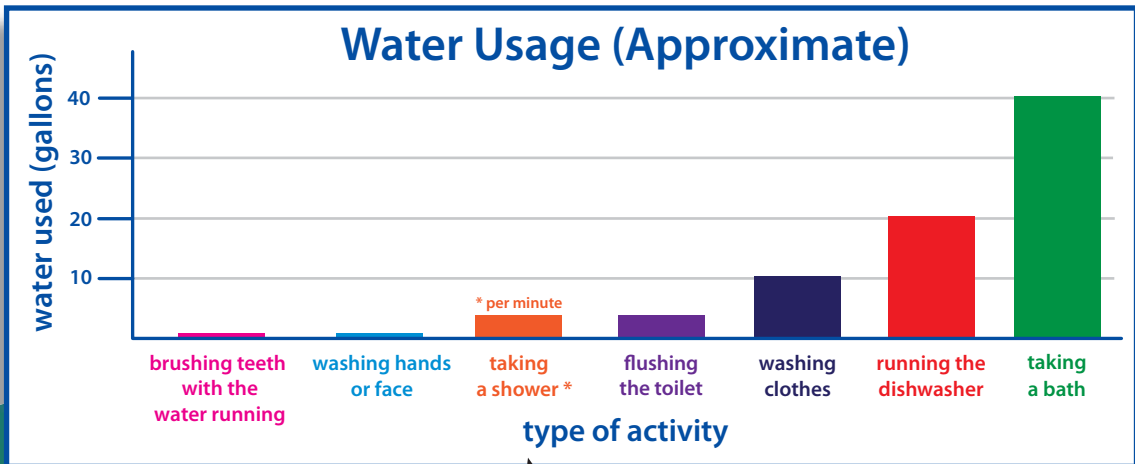


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The students use about 68 gallons of water each day. They graph the **data** from their chart to see which activities use the most water.



LET'S EXPLORE MATH

Look at the graph above. Then, answer the questions.

- Which activity uses the most water?
- How much more water is used to run the dishwasher than to wash clothes?
- Which activities use equal amounts of water?

Then the students think of ways they can use less water. They can turn off the water while brushing their teeth. They can turn off the water when they rub soap on their hands. They can spend less time in the shower.
