Shapes are all around you. Take a look around your classroom. What shapes can you see?

Your classroom has many shapes.



Look at the flag of the United States of America in the classroom.

- a. Name the different shapes you can see.
- **b.** How many of each shape are there? *Hint:* Look for the shape of the flag as well as the shapes inside it.

Think about the shapes on your **route** to school. The steering wheel on a school bus is a circle. Do you pass any traffic lights that are circles?



Perhaps you stop at a crosswalk. Is it made from rectangles? Look at the road signs. Are there any shaped like triangles?

All of these shapes are known as 2-D shapes.
