

## What Are You Feeling? What Are You Thinking?

★ Pretend a new movie starring a sandwich has just come out. It could be a funny movie, a scary movie, or even a mystery! What is the name of the movie?

★ How does the storyteller know their classmate isn't mean? Why is this fact important?

★ Why do you think the classmate makes fun of the sandwich? What sentences help you answer that question?

★ Do you like the way the book ends? Why or why not? What would you do in a similar situation?

★ Have you been hungry or do you know someone who might not have enough healthy food? You can ask for help from a trusted adult.
