

Phillis Wheatley was born in western Africa around 1753.

When Phillis was seven years old, she was kidnapped. She was taken on a boat to Boston, Massachusetts. Then, she was sold as a slave.

Phillis was a very smart little girl. She learned to read and write English quickly. She soon became colonial America's first black poet.
