Category 1: Mindset Standards: School counselors encourage the following mindsets for all students.

M 1.	Belief in development of whole self, including a healthy balance of mental, social/emotional and physical well-being
M 2.	Sense of acceptance, respect, support and inclusion for self and others in the school environment
M 3.	Positive attitude toward work and learning
M 4.	Self-confidence in ability to succeed
M 5.	Belief in using abilities to their fullest to achieve high-quality results and outcomes
M 6.	Understanding that postsecondary education and life-long learning are necessary for long-term success
