Skill Overview: Understanding Characters

Analyzing characters allows readers to understand how a character's choices, motivations, and character traits influence the plot or sequence of events. Readers are required to understand all aspects of a character. Then, they are able to understand a character and how their decisions influence a story. In *The Boy Who Loved Books*, Hector Quarta's character is both explicitly stated (he loved books) and implicitly stated through the types of books he enjoys (his love of mysteries indicates that he is a problem solver) and his reading behaviors.

Reteach

Reinforce

Average Gains on the *Focused Mathematics Intervention* Pretest and Posttest





- Refer students to the Math in the Real World: Class Party task (*Student Guided Practice Book*, page 60). Have a student read the task aloud. Tell students to explain or summarize the task to their partner. Have a few students share their summaries.
- Ask students to think about what information they will need to solve the task, as well as what the task is asking them to do. Then, have them share with a partner. Ask a few students to share out. Students should identify that we know how many bags each student brought and how many apple slices were in each bag. We need to find out how many apple slices each student brought in all, and then compare these totals to decide who brought more. Have students work in groups of two or three to complete the task.
