

Sample Pacing Framework for Remote Learning

Building Vocabulary, Levels K-2

This pacing framework demonstrates how the program can be used in a remote learning environment. Each lesson component can be delivered in a variety of ways: live sessions; recorded videos; or independent, student-directed work. Teachers can adjust the pacing and delivery method to best meet the needs of their students.

Part 2	Let's Play (20 Minutes)	Live or recorded classroom meeting: Reread poem (slide available) Review and discuss sound/root Model work for student pages	SGPB: Let's Play
Part 3	Let's Read (20 Minutes)	Live or recorded classroom meeting: Introduce sound/root (slide available) Read and reread poem (slide available) Identify, compare, and discuss sound/root Add to virtual word wall	SGPB: Let's Read
Part 4	Let's Play (20 Minutes)	Live or recorded classroom meeting: Reread poem (slide available) Review and discuss sound/root Model work for student pages	SGPB: Let's Play
Part 5	Let's Grow (20 minutes)	Live or recorded classroom meeting: Review, compare, and discuss sound/root Synthesize learning with activities Model work for student pages	SGPB: Let's Grow
Optional	Review	Assess student learning as needed	SGPB: Review Pages
